OVERVIEW

One out of three people alive today in the United States will ultimately suffer of cancer. Are surgery, chemotherapy, and radiation therapy the only options for cancer patients, will there be any alternative available? As many as 69 percent cancer patients seek help from herbs and other alternative therapies. A growing number of people with cancer are now beginning to realize the benefits offered by integrative medicine as a means of cancer management, hope for an improvement, and what preventive methods are used. We propose a neuro-bioenergetic concept of pathogenesis based on the central mechanism of cellular hyperexcitability via inducible overexpression of voltage-gated ion channels, ligand-gated channels and neurotransmitters. Exploration of this concept could lead to a better understanding of the cause of cancer as well as developing more effective and specific strategic toward cancer prevention and management.

SPEAKER PROFILE

Dr Ba Hoang combines scientific worldwide research and development to blend western and eastern medicine. Jean-Paul Deslypere got his medical degree from the University of Gent in Belgium in 1977. After graduation he specialized in Internal Medicine/Endocrinology and started a scientific career at the Belgian National Fund of Scientific Research (NFSR) and at the University of Gent. He obtained his PhD in Endocrinology and Metabolic Diseases in 1984. Being clinically active he was director of the Endocrine Lab at the University and also Head of the Metabolic and Lipid Disorder Clinic of the University Hospital.

He spend two years (1987-1988) at the Dept of Human Nutrition (Agricultural University Wageningen) where he worked with Prof M.Katan and one year (1991) at the Dept of Medicine (University of Texas South Western Medical School Dallas) where he worked with Prof Jean Wilson.

In 1992 he was appointed Professor of Endocrinology and Research Director at the NFSR. Jean-Paul Deslypere left the University in 1997 and started working for the clinical trial industry, first as Director International Operations of a central lab (BARC) and subsequently as Regional Director Asia Pacific for ICON Clinical Research based in Singapore. In 2002 he joined the Singapore Government as Research Director National Healthcare Group and the National University Singapore as Adjunct Professor. After having been Director of the Singapore Government's CRO (CTERU) for two years, Jean-Paul Deslypere joined SGS Life Sciences in February 2006 as Business Development Manager Asia Pacific. He is currently also Director of the Singapore Good Clinical Practice Programme.



Dr Yuen Chuen Fong Raymond, MBBS, M Med (OM), FAMS is the Occupational Physician at Hosanna Medical Centre and founder of Traditional Chinese Medicine & Therapy Centre. He is the Medical Advisor and former president of CareCancer Society and Chairman of Kowloon Medical professional Group.
